DELEGATIONS

Introduction of Asset Management Initiatives Manager

A. McGifford, Director of Finance introduced the City's new Manager of Asset Management Initiatives, K. Orchiston. The new position will focus on the financial assets and investments of the City.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Five Year Financial Plan Q&A Summary

The Director of Finance presented a summary of questions and responses as it relates to the 2024-2028 Financial Planning process.

BYLAWS

"City of Port Alberni 2024-2028 Financial Plan Bylaw No. 5097, 2024" was adopted. The Financial Plan requires adoption annually prior to May 15th in order to set tax rates, complete all filing and distribute tax notices.

"City of Port Alberni Tax Rates Bylaw No. 5104, 2024" was deferred to a future meeting to permit additional information to be presented to Council regarding historical allocation of tax rate shares across classes.
