

# Mayor John Douglas:

With regards to council's recent cancellation of the Gertrude Bridge widening project I find some serious concerns to myself, family, neighbours and all others using this bridge.

The compressed curb to curb width of the vehicle deck coupled with its extremely narrow walkways, combined with the flow of heavy traffic in opposing directions presents a serious hazard. This is a bridge used by middle school students, neighbourhood residents, and dike users alike. There is high pedestrian traffic using this confining bridge. One can witness families pushing strollers, riding bikes, walking dogs, all having to be done in a single file while rushing across and literally trying to "hug the railing" just be as physically afar from traffic as possible.

I and others both frequenting and living in the area have been in discussion on this matter and overwhelmingly agree it is not if, but when an incident will occur and we are very hopeful that you might reconsider your decision on this project.
