■ DELEGATIONS

■ STAFF REPORTS

Public Works Vehicle Tenders 2018

Council approved two vehicle tenders to Alberni Chrysler, one truck with service body in the amount of \$90,111.00 plus taxes with funding from ERRF, and a one ton truck with service body in the amount of \$88,230.00 plus taxes with funding from ERRF and the funds received from the sale of vehicles.

Development Permit – 3033 3rd Avenue

Council denied a request for an extension of a development permit for 3033 – 3rd Avenue.
