Action: Rosalind Chapman will talk to the City administration to see what can be done to promote the page

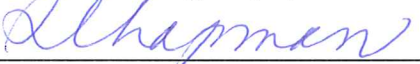
- John Mayba will attend the Traffic Advisory Meeting and will report back to the committee.

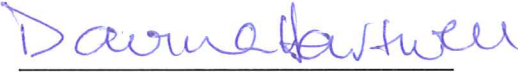
