■ DELEGATIONS

Introduction of Manager of Recreation Services

Willa Thorpe, Director of Parks, Recreation and Heritage introduced Jeff Toews, new Manager of Recreation Services who commenced his role with the City last week.

Log Pond Dam Project

Council received a report from the CAO recommending that the log pond dam remediation project resume. A further report responding to additional questions from Council will be provided to the next regular meeting.
