#### PUBLIC INPUT

Richard Andrew commented about the lack of progress made at property located on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, specifically, construction work that has not transpired although a permit had been issued for the works approximately two years ago.

#### STAFF REPORTS

Award of General Municipal Engineering Services Council awarded RFP No. 005-22 General Municipal Engineering Services to Koers & Associates Engineering Ltd. for a term of three years commencing June 1, 2022 through to May 31, 2025.

## Financial Plan Amendment and Award of Proposal | Argyle Sewer Forcemain

Council directed staff to amend the "City of Port Alberni 2022-2026 Financial Plan Bylaw No. 5045, 2022" as follows:

- i. Delay the Harbour Road Trunk Sewer Replacement Project expenditure of \$300,000 in 2022 and \$300,000 in 2023, to 2024 [\$600,000 plus inflationary provisions] and reallocate \$600,000 to the Argyle Sewer Forcemain Project [Somass River Crossing] in 2022.
- ii. Reallocate \$437,930 of underspent funding from Phase 3 and 4 of the Coal Creek Sewer Separation Project [Project No.'s 20090, 21038, 21037, and 21044] to the Argyle Sewer Forcemain Project [Somas River Crossing] in 2022.
- iii. Provide \$732,070 from the Water Infrastructure Reserve Fund to the Argyle Sewer Forcemain Project [Somass River Crossing] in the year 2022.

Council then proceeded to award RFP No. 006-22 Argyle Sanitary Forcemain Somass River Crossing to Industra Construction Corp. in the amount of \$2,922,483.77 excluding GST.

#### Statement of Financial Information

Council approved the statements and schedules included in the Statement of Financial Information for 2021, prepared to comply with the Financial Information Act.

#### 2021 Development Cost Charges

Council received the report from the Director of Finance dated June 6, 2022 and titled "2021 Development Cost Charges".

#### BYLAW

#### "Zoning Map Amendment No. 51 (5450 Greenard Street – Hopkins), Bylaw No. 5056"

was introduced and given two readings. Given the amendment aligns with the City's OCP, Council proceeded to waive the public hearing in accordance with section 464 (2) of the Local Government Act [LGA]. While a formal public hearing will not be held regarding the amendment application, legislation requires that public notice is still given [in accordance with section 467 of the LGA] prior to Council considering further readings of the Bylaw.

"Official Community Plan Amendment No. 37 (4738 Athol Street - Rai), Bylaw No. 5046", "Zoning Text Amendment No. T31 (CD2 – Comprehensive Development – Multi-Family Residential Infill – 4738 Athol Street), Bylaw No. 5047" and "Zoning Map Amendment No. 48 (4738 Athol Street - Rai), Bylaw No. 5048" were introduced, given first and second readings, and advanced to a Public Hearing to be held on Monday, July 11, 2022 at 6:00 pm in City Hall Council Chambers.

The proposed bylaws upon adoption will enable a high density, multi-family infill development at 4738 Athol Street.

"Zoning Map Amendment No. 50 (5249 Pineo Road – Hammer), Bylaw No. 5049" was read a third time. As part of the development process for 5249 Pineo Road the applicant will be required to complete the following before Council considers final adoption of the Bylaw.

- Geotechnical report
- Stormwater management plan
- Site grading plan
- Design and estimate for required off-site works
- Receive a subdivision Preliminary Layout Review letter from the City's Approving Officer.

"Sign Bylaw Amendment No. T1 (4109 Kendall Avenue – Seventh Day Adventist Church), Bylaw No. 5055" was adopted. The bylaw will enable the installation of a Freestanding Sign at 4109 Kendall Avenue.

"City of Port Alberni Election and Assent Voting Bylaw No. 5054, 2022" was introduced and given first, second and third reading. The bylaw upon adoption will create the opportunity for eligible electors to vote by mail in the upcoming general local elections taking place October 15, 2022.

"City of Port Alberni Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 5050, 2022" was introduced and given first, second and third reading. The proposed bylaw, upon adoption will authorize collection of an application fee of \$10 for each access request made.

Council authorized the Port Alberni Funtastic Sports Society to host the Okee Dokee Slo-Pitch Tournament including concert and beer garden taking place July 1 to July 3, 2022 at the following City locations, Echo Park Ball Fields, Russell Fields, Bob Dailey Stadium and Field subject to:

- confirmation that PAFSS has received an approved Special Event Permit;
- PAFSS providing notification of the event to emergency services and BC Transit; and
- provision of standard liability insurance in the amount of \$5M [minimum]
