PUBLIC INPUT

Roland Smith

Spoke to the process involved with public requests for access to City information and records.

DELEGATIONS

Alberni Valley Community Forest Corporation Chairman, Jim Sears, and members of the Board presented a dividend cheque from the Alberni Valley Community Forest Corporation in the amount of \$300,000.

Council expressed their sincere appreciation to the Corporation for their dedication and impeccable management of the Community Forest which continues to provide numerous benefits to the community.

STAFF REPORTS

Development Application | 3045 and 3053 Kingsway Avenue

Council authorized the issuance of Development Variance Permit No.113 for 3045 and 3053 Kingsway Avenue granting variances to setbacks and parcel coverage, bringing the existing property into compliance and facilitating the issuance of Development Permit No. 22-02 enabling construction of a four (4) unit multifamily building.

Temporary Use Permit | **3665**, **3675**, **3689 4**th **Ave.** Council directed staff to issue a Temporary Use Permit [TUP] on City Lands [3665, 3675, 3689 4th Ave.] for Transition House Use [Tiny Shelters].

Council further authorized the Letter of Intent between the City, Port Alberni Friendship Centre and BC Housing and execution of the 2-year lease agreement with the Friendship Center providing for the operation of a low barrier transitional housing development on the aforementioned properties.

BYLAWS

"Zoning Map Amendment No. 54 Bylaw No. 5064" was introduced and given two readings. Given the amendment aligns with the City's Official Community Plan, Council proceeded to waive the public hearing.

The proposed bylaw upon adoption would enable the applicant, Dog Mountain Brewing, to rezone 3151 3rd Avenue from C5 Transitional Office to C7 Core Business expanding their non-brewing business operations (kitchen, lounge, office, picnic area) onto the neighbouring property.

"City of Port Alberni, Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 5068, 2022" and "City of Port Alberni, Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 5069, 2022" were introduced and given three readings.

The bylaws upon adoption will enable the applicants [Alberni Drug and Alcohol Society, Kuu-us Crisis Line Society and Island Corridor Foundation] to receive permissive tax exemptions as per the Community Charter which provides Council the authority for both permissive and statutory tax exemptions for properties owned by a charitable, philanthropic or other not-for-profit corporation.
