## LIFEGUARD / INSTRUCTOR (Full-Time, Temporary)

The City of Port Alberni is a vibrant community of 17,500 people. Located centrally on Vancouver Island, Port Alberni is a well-serviced municipality that offers residents affordable west coast living, as well as proximity to oceanfront, lakes, rivers and mountains.

The City is currently looking for a full-time Lifeguard/Instructor to join our team at the Aquatic Centre. The successful candidate will perform lifeguard, swim instruction and fitness leadership duties, ensuring the safety and enjoyment of guests at all swim sessions. The full-time Lifeguard/Instructor is a mentor, coach and leader on and off the pool deck, and supports the Aquatic Programmer in the delivery of our programs and services. This position also responds to emergencies and incidents requiring first aid.

The successful candidate will be enthusiastic, reliable and responsible and will possess the following qualifications/certificates:

- Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent
- A minimum of 3 years of aquatic experience
- Current National Lifeguard (NL)
- Current Red Cross or Lifesaving Society Standard First Aid with CPR-C/AED
- Current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor (WSI)
- Current Lifesaving Society Instructor (LSI)
- Current BCRPA Fitness Instructor or equivalent
- 2 additional instructor trainer certificates or specialty instructor certifications (i.e. Water Safety Instructor Trainer, National Lifeguard Instructor, First Aid Instructor, Lifesaving Instructor Trainer)

Note: The full-time Lifeguard/Instructor schedule will include varying days, evenings and weekends.

This is full-time temporary position that is expected to be 12 months in duration. In addition, there is a likelihood that continued full-time employment will be available following the term of this position. The current rate of pay is \$31.44 per hour, plus 15% in lieu of benefits.

The successful candidate will be required to successfully complete a Police Information Check and a pre-employment fitness evaluation.
