The City of Port Alberni is accepting applications from enthusiastic, reliable and qualified candidates to work part-time as lifeguards/swim instructors at the Aquatic Centre.

Applicants must have completed Grade 10, have good customer service skills and be available to work weekends and evenings. Applicants must also have the following certifications:

- National Lifeguard (NL)
- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor
- CPR C (within the last year)
- Standard or Aquatic Emergency Care First Aid (within the last 2 years)

Qualified applicants will first be selected to take part in a PINS (Potential Incoming New Staff) session which will include an evaluation of written and practical teaching assignments and a practical life guarding session (including simulations). Following completion of the PINS session, candidates will be selected for interviews.

Rate of pay is per the CUPE Local 118 Collective Agreement. Successful candidates will be required to complete a Police Information Check.
