



CITY OF PORT ALBERNI NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Sections 464, 465, and 466 of the *Local Government Act*, Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held electronically by Zoom Webinar on **Tuesday, March 9, 2021 at 6:00 pm** to hear representation about the following proposed bylaw:

A. “Zoning Bylaw Text Amendment No. T27 (Site Specific Use – C2 General Commercial), Bylaw No. 5022”.

APPLICANT: D. Firouzli, Architect - The applicant is applying to amend the Zoning Bylaw to facilitate the development of a Liquor, Wine and Beer Store at 2943 10th Avenue (Quality Foods grocery store). The amendment being considered is as follows:

A. Zoning Bylaw Text Amendment:

Applying to amend the text of Port Alberni Zoning Bylaw 2014, No. 4832 by adding the following text to Section 5.19.4 C2 General Commercial Site Specific Uses table:
